

## Reception - Year 6

#### Dear Parents,

Each year at St Joseph's, we offer our students a variety of extra-curricular activities to educate and entertain them in different ways, all of which are partly subsidised through the "location loading" under our Commonwealth funding. The performances booked for this year, along with a brief description, are as follows:

#### Term 1

#### Silly Scientist Show Years R - 6 only Monday 5 February

An interactive performance which aims to promote positive attitudes to participating in science related activities. Presenters demonstrate fun and exciting activities from the Science Understanding strands of the Australian Curriculum, including biological, chemical, earth, space and physical sciences.

#### Term 2

#### Taiko Drumming Years 4-6 Wednesday 29 May

This hands-on workshop allows students to play Taiko, learning basic to advanced skills depending on each student's ability. A highly engaging session.

#### Clare Valley Dance Rec - Yr 6 Mondays, Weeks 1-5 (make-up classes in Week 6)

These fun and fabulous lessons will take place over 5 weeks in Term 2 and all students from Reception to Year 6 will be involved. Lessons are aligned with the Australian Curriculum Performing Arts (Dance) learning achievement standards and look at why we dance, dance history and cultural dances. A great source of fun and enjoyment, dance allow students to meet and socialise whilst maintaining a high level of fitness.

#### Backflips Against Bullying Rec - Yr 9 Tuesday 11 June

A high-energy performance by a team of incredible acrobats, this show explores the importance of connectedness. By addressing bullying on a social level, students will be provided with the necessary tools to empower them to hold each other accountable. Three age-appropriate sessions will be run across the day.

#### Term 3

#### Glow & Tell (Patch Theatre) Rec - Yr 2 only Date TBA

Blending the magic of light and simplicity of storytelling, students are placed at the centre of this engaging, interactive experience. Using UV light, in a custom-built tent, the classroom is transformed into an intimate performance space, where stories and imagined worlds come alive as glowing drawings appear on the walls and floor. Following the performance, students are invited to create and illustrate their own stories in glowing UV light.

PLEASE NOTE - The cost of these performances, and the traditional end of year Cinema Excursion, will be billed on your school account across Terms 1 – 4 (Rec - Yr 2: \$13.05 per term, Yr 3: \$10.05 per term, Yr 4 - Yr 6: \$11.65 per term). Additionally, if your child/ren are unable to attend a particular performance you will not be refunded the amount as performance fees are negotiated (sometimes several months in advance), based on our student numbers. The performances, along with a brief description, are as follows:

#### Term 3

Designed to both illuminate and entertain!

PLEASE NOTE - The cost of these additional performances will be 50% subsidised by the school through the 'location loading' in our Commonwealth funding. The remaining 50% will be charged to your Term 3 fees.

Additionally, if your child/ren are unable to attend a particular performance you will not be refunded the amount as performance fees have negotiated based on our student numbers. Following is pricing (per student) for your information.
